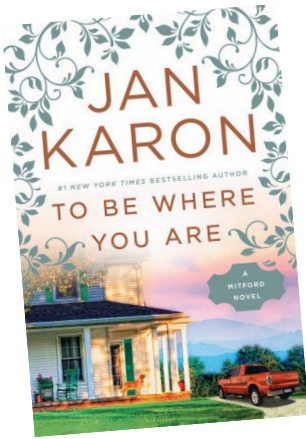
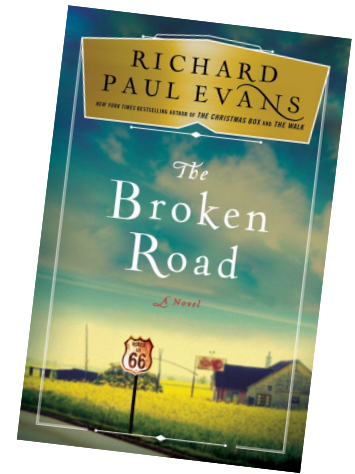

To Be Where You Are

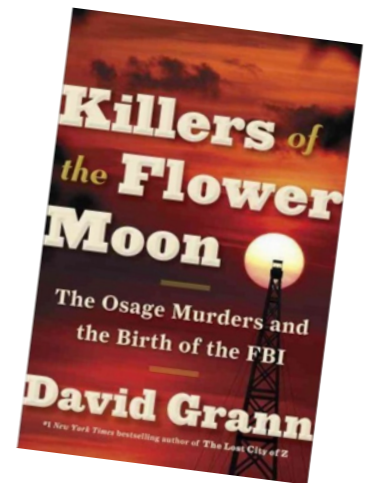
