This month's "From the Heart" reflects a "Change of Heart!" For this Advent season, I had decided to lead us in a worship series regarding our souls waiting for God's promised salvation. But instead of that, I'd like for us to explore some hymns... Christmas Hymns.

In his book, Hymns of Christmas, John Zehring writes,

"Christmas music about Jesus Christ goes places that no other message about Jesus can reach. The hymns play in the stores, the home, the office, the car. Music reaches people who have hardly darkened the door of a church and even if the listeners do not own the words, those hymns seep into their minds and who knows what effect they might have? A person could not stand up in a store or an airport and talk about Jesus,

but music carries the message Joy to the World! The Lord is come!" (Zehring, John. Hymns of Christmas. Arlington, John Zehring Publishing, 2021.)


It is my hope that as we focus on a different Christmas hymn each week, its story, inspiration and scriptural anchor will draw us closer into the heart of God when we sing it.

Parkford Apartments – Continuing Outreach

This past summer, through our participation in the Children's Food Network lunch program, First Bethel began to form a connection with the community of Parkford Apartments in South Park. In an effort to continue to grow this connection and further engage with the children and youth of Parkford,



the Outreach Committee hopes to provide monthly gatherings for the community's children and youth consisting of a hot meal, crafts, stories, games, and if desired, help with homework.

Our first gathering was a Halloween party held on October 28th. Utilizing the green space outside of the community's office center, we had numerous games including basketball, soccer, corn hole, egg races and hula hoop contests. Lilly and Amy Zeminski contributed their considerable craft skills and helped the children paint pumpkins and create several Halloween themed decorations. Pizza, fresh fruit, cookies and (of course!) candy was served, and even with some rain toward the end, all enjoyed the day. We were delighted to reconnect with some of the children and caregivers we had met during the summer meal program, and were very happy to see several new faces and make some new friends. We also met Pastor Kelly Gilliam of South Park's Shiloh Church, which has a long history of outreach to the Parkford community, and are excited at the possibility of cooperating together on future programs.




Friday, December 15 – A Life in Light – Mary Pipher
